

# Tri-Cities Fever Girls

## *Frequently Asked Questions*

### 1. What are we looking for in a “Fever Girl?”

We are looking for girls that have a lot of energy, outgoing, great people person. They need to be in great physical shape. All of our performing outfits are two pieces. They need to have rhythm, not necessarily dance/cheer background. Our routines will be short and have a cheer style. We are looking for girls that have showmanship and confidence in front of large crowds.

### 2. What is the tryout format?

There will be 3 clinics. December 10<sup>th</sup>, January 7<sup>th</sup> and January 21<sup>st</sup>. In-between clinics 2 & 3 on Thursday, January 14<sup>th</sup>, we will have a practice (no charge) at 6:30. Prospective members are encouraged to attend all 4 dates as we will be using the routines learned for performances. You will learn a new routine each time we meet. The clinics and tryouts are held at Starfit in Kennewick. The application can be found on-line. Please wear a two piece outfit to all clinics and tryouts. Registration begins at 6:30. We will begin with a warm-up at 7:00. We will teach a short routine, work on rhythm, technique, showmanship and confidence. January 21<sup>st</sup> will be the final tryout. Girls wishing to be performing at games or only promotional girls must attend the final clinic/tryout on January 21<sup>st</sup>.

### 3. What is the involvement with community service and/or charities?

Each Fever Girl is required to participate in two community and/or charity events each month. You are expected to be actively involved in the community for the Fever season March-July, but you are a Fever Girl and will be needed at promotional events from when you are selected until the next year’s team is selected.

### 4. What is the age requirement?

You must be 18 or be a senior in high school with parent consent. There is no age limit.

### 5. What is the time commitment?

- Practices will be held once a week on Thursday evenings for the 2010 season. Practices begin on January 28<sup>th</sup> and run through July. Practice will be from 6:30-10:00.
- 8 home games (we do not travel) Game schedule should be released by mid December
- Promotional events twice a month

### 6. What does it pay? Do the girls have to pay?

- Each performer will be paid \$25 a game
- Members selected will be required to pay for their own go-go boots (est. \$40)
- Members selected are required to have a \$500 months’ sponsor for the “Fever Girl” calendar.

### 7. Are there any other items we get compensated for?

- 2 tickets to each home game
- Gym membership at Starfit
- Possible free or reduced tanning
- Possible free or reduced haircuts & color
